



# KAPOW LESSON PLAN

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School *Orchard Villa Elementary*

Grade Level *3*

Lesson Plan Title:

KAPOW Curriculum Level 2 KAPOW Lesson Number 7 Page 103

Objectives: *Identify various forms of communication. The student will recognize the importance of communication skills in conflict resolution.*

SSS/CBC's: *LA C. 3.2.3.: The student speaks for specific occasions, audiences, and purposes – including conversations, discussions, projects and informational or imaginative presentations.*

Step-By-Step Procedures: *(1) Intro-explain “how you say it” premises.  
(2) Model – sentence generation and performance.  
(3) Students generate sentences.  
(4) Students take turns performing (pick words from bag).  
(5) Discuss Results.*

Required Materials: *“How you say it words, hat or bag for word strips. Students generate phrases, sentences.*

Assessment Based On Objectives: *Participation*

Adaptations for ESE, and LEP, and low achievers: *Illustrate emotions/expressions.*

Homework: *Write a reflection on the activity – How did you feel when someone said something negative/positive?*

Extensions (For Gifted Students): *(1) List antonyms and synonyms of words in bag,  
(2) Write and perform a skit in which a person uses both negative  
And positive expressions and outcomes.*

Integration: Connections To Other Subjects: *Language Arts, Social Studies (conflict resolution)  
(author’s purpose/ viewpoint, cause and effect, types of sentences.*
